CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for Club Championship points, an individual must be a fully paid member of the Caernarvonshire & Anglesey Motor Club Limited (C&AMC).

QUALIFYING EVENTS

Qualifying events will be specified for each individual award.

CHAMPIONSHIP TERM

The championship will run annually from 1st of January to 31st of December.

CLAIMING POINTS

- Points cannot be awarded retrospectively for events where the individuals was not a member at that time.
- Points will be awarded automatically for all competitors on C&AMC organised events
- For all other events, members must submit their results via the electronic form on the C&A Motor Club website within 30 days of the event results going final.
- All marshalling points claims, whether for C&AMC organised events or others, must be submitted via the electronic form on the C&A Motor Club website within 30 days of the event.

The championship coordinator reserves the rights to request proof of results from a member.

Wherever possible the championship coordinator will aim to provide interim results periodically during the championship term.

Interim results shall remain provisional at all times.

Final results shall be published no later than the 31st of January.

SCORING

In each competitive championship, the best 8 scores will count.

There is no limit on attendance-based championships and the marshal's championship.

Points scoring will be as follows:

All attendance-based championships:

- 1 point awarded per event attendance.

All competitive championships:

Point systems shall follow the regulations of an event when awarding overall vs. class awards. Points will be allocated based on the event's final results.

- 1st overall: 20pts
- 2nd overall: 18pts

- 3rd overall: 15pts
 - The above point scorers will not be eligible for class points.
- 1st in class: 10pts; 2nd in class: 9pts, down to 8th in class: 3pts.
- All other class finishers will score 2 points
- Non-finishers score 1

If an event amalgamates classes, then the amalgamated class structure shall be used to score points.

Dual permit events shall be scored as one event for marshals.

Where an individual competes in multiple cars (E.G. PCA navigators), only the score of their highest placement on the final results will go towards the championship.

Marshalling:

- Named officials on any events shall be awarded 15 points in the discipline of the event (maximum of 2 claims per discipline).
- Signed-on marshals on any events shall be awarded 10 points in the discipline of the event (maximum of 2 claims per discipline).

This allows for a maximum of 50pts per discipline.

Navigation Runs:

- 1st overall: 12pts, through to 12th overall: 1pt
- Organisers shall score 10pts per event organised (maximum of 2 claims).

DISCIPLINES

For the purposes of the competitive championships, the disciplines are recognised as per the below table and are consisted with individual discipline-based awards:

- To qualify for the All-Rounders award, a contender must have scored points in a minimum of three disciplines.
- Novice status is determined by a competitor's status at the start of the championship year, regardless of the year's results.

Note: For each discipline the definition of a Novice competitor is shown

Annual Awards and Championships

Attendance Based Awards	
Don Mills Patron's Cup	Awarded to the C&AMC member of the year. This is awarded to the member who has attended the most C&AMC organised events (formerly the Aggregate Cup).
Irfonwy Jones Memorial Cup	Awarded to the runner up member in the Don Mills' Patron's Cup table.
Ken Jones Junior Cup	Awarded to the highest placed male junior member (under 18 yrs of age at the beginning of the championship term) in the Don Mills Patron's Cup table.
Brenda Cup	Awarded to the highest placed female junior member (under 18 yrs of age at the beginning of the championship term) in the Don Mills Patron's Cup table.
Olwen Cup	Awarded to the highest placed lady member in the Don Mills Patron's Cup table.
Marshal's Cup	Awarded to the member of the year who has marshalled on the most C&AMC organised events.
Ieuan Roberts Marshal's Trophy	Awarded to the member who has marshalled on the most events (all events qualify) throughout the year.

Competition Based Awards	
Ivor Jones Novice Trophy	Awarded to the highest placed Novice competitor on all C&AMC organised competitive events.
McNair Shield	Awarded to the competitor with the highest points tally from competitive events organised by C&AMC.
Bryn Bras Cup	Awarded to the competitor with the highest points tally from events qualifying for Motorsport UK recognised championships.
Jubilee Cup	Awarded to the Lady Competitor of the year. All competitive disciplines qualify.
Joy Evans Trophy	Awarded to the All-Round competitor of the year on C&AMC organised events only. Must have taken part in a minimum of three disciplines from the above table.
Ferodo Rose Bowl	Awarded to the Autotest driver of the year. All Autotest events qualify.
Dave Jones Challenge Trophy	Awarded to the Autotest driver of the year on events in North Wales.
M Shield	Awarded to the Production Car Autotest driver of the year on PCAs organised by C&AMC.
A Shield	Awarded to the Autotest driver of the year on Autotests organised by C&AMC.
S Shield	Awarded to the Production Car Autotest navigator of the year on PCAs organised by C&AMC.
Arthur Green Shield	Awarded to the Car Trials driver of the year. All Trial events qualify.
Lee Matthews Cup	Awarded to the Road Rally driver of the year. All Road Rallies qualify.

Kath Rumney Cup	Awarded to the Road Rally navigator of the year. All Road Rallies qualify.
Vera Cup	Awarded to the Tarmac Stage Rally driver of the year. All sealed surface Stage Rallies qualify.
Regent Cup	Awarded to the Tarmac Stage Rally Co-Driver of the year. All sealed surface Stage Rallies qualify.
Campbell Cup	Awarded to the Forest Stage Rally driver of the year. All unsealed surface Stage Rallies qualify.
John Collinge Rose Bowl	Awarded to the Forest Stage Rally Co-Driver of the year. All unsealed surface Stage Rallies qualify.
Godiva Cup	Awarded to the Lady Rally Driver of the year. All Rallies qualify.
Yvonne Matthews Cup	Awarded to the Lady Rally Navigator/Co-Driver of the year. All Rallies qualify.
Catrin Cup	Awarded to the Navigation Run Champion(s). All Navigation Runs, Treasure Hunts and Scatters qualify.
Duncan's Romer	Awarded to the Winter Navigation Run champion. Qualifying events are Navigation Runs organised by C&AMC held during the months January, February, March, October, November and December (Best 4 of 6, 3 of 5, 3 of 4, 2 of 3, 2 of 2, 1 of 1 rounds to count).
Gary Matthews Achievement Trophy	Awarded to a member who, in the opinion of the Club Committee, has achieved the most in motorsport during the year.
Dewi Hughes Memorial Trophy	Awarded to a member who, in the opinion of the Club Committee, has made a significant contribution to motorsport.
