FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for your entry for the 2025 Kennings Autotest and PCA; we hope you enjoy your day's motorsport on Anglesey.

We will also accept cash at signing-on if more convenient.

DIRECTIONS TO THE VENUE.

We would like to extend our sincere thanks to the staff at Trac Môn for allowing us the use of the venue; we are very grateful for their invaluable support and assistance.

Once onto Anglesey, exit the A55 at Junction 5 for the A4080 and follow brown chequered flag signs for Race Circuit. Please note there are no local petrol stations near the venue. The closest is in Gaerwen, just off junction 7 of the A55 (LL60 6HL). There is a convenience (Spar) store on the A4080 at Llanfaelog, en-route to the venue.

Should you encounter problems on your journey, please contact our Entries Secretary, Dafydd, on 07759 034647.

Toilets and refreshments are available at the venue. Please support the booty van.

PROCEDURE – see plan below.

Access the circuit through the Main Gate, then take the first right, along the Spectator Access Road, towards the Medical Centre and Circuit Office.

On arrival park as directed (see diagram). You can keep your trailer with your tow vehicles and car in the parking area. **PLEASE DO NOT PARK ON THE GRASS.**

Once unloaded please report to the Circuit Office for signing-on.

Please remember your club membership cards, competition licence and any outstanding payments.

The scrutineer will come round to your car. Main things are battery and seat security, brakes and steering.

There are two events taking place, a PCA during the morning and the Autotest in the afternoon.

PCA TIMETABLE:

Signing on and scrutineering starts at **08:15 hours** and ends at **08:45 hours**.

Driver's briefing will be in the signing on office at **08:45 hours**.

First test to commence at **09:00 hours**. The number and order of tests will be decided by the Clerk of the Course on the day. Competitors will be permitted to walk the tests before 09:00 hours.

The last test will be at approximately **11:00 hours**.

PCA competitors are then asked to support the club by remaining at the venue to marshal on the Autotest that follows.

AUTOTEST TIMETABLE:

Signing on and scrutineering starts at **09:00 hours** and ends at **11:30 hours**.

There will be a marshals meeting at **11:30 hours** on test site A.

Driver's briefing will be in the signing on office at **11:45 hours**.

First test to commence at **12:00 hours**. There are three test areas which should be completed in alphabetical order. The number of rounds will be decided by the Clerk of the Course on the day, although it is anticipated there will be six rounds, with a short break after the first three.

The last test will be at approximately **17:00 hours**.

The later than normal schedule we hope will reduce the amount of traffic you encounter on the journey home eastwards along the A55 at this time of the year. To get off the Island at peak times during the summer the locals often use the A5 from Gaerwen (Junction 7 of A55), through Llanfairpwll and join the A55 at Britannia Bridge. You may wish to do the same.

Test A will be open for "walking" until the first car starts that test at 12:00 hours.

Tests B & C will be open for "walking" from approximately 10:30 hours, as soon as the last PCA car has finished each site.

Test D is for the PCA only.
