Thank you for your entry for the 2026 Kennings Autotest and PCA; we hope you enjoy your day's motorsport on Anglesey.

If you still need to pay your entry fee, a reminder that you may make a bank transfer to: **C & A Motor Club, Sort Code 40-16-02, Account No 01166034**. Please use the reference: KEN and the driver's name.

A bank transfer is our preferred option, but we will also accept cash at signing-on if more convenient.

DIRECTIONS TO THE VENUE.

We would like to extend our sincere thanks to the staff at Trac Môn for allowing us the use of the venue; we are very grateful for their invaluable support and assistance.

Once onto Anglesey, exit the A55 at Junction 5 for the A4080 and follow brown chequered flag signs for Race Circuit. Please note there are no local petrol stations near the venue. The closest is in Gaerwen, just off junction 7 of the A55 (LL60 6HL). There is a convenience (Spar) store on the A4080 at Llanfaelog, en-route to the venue.

Toilets and refreshments are available at the venue. Please support the booty van.

PROCEDURE – see plan below.

Please NOTE this is a Race Circuit venue, and as such DOGS are NOT permitted.

Access the circuit through the Main Gate, then take the first right, along the Spectator Access Road, towards the Medical Centre and Circuit Office.

Those who wish to camp the night before may do so in and around the area designated for parking our trailers and cars near the signing on buildings. This is free of charge. No fires and please be quiet. Not sure what time they lock the gate.

On arrival park as directed (see diagram). You can keep your trailer with your tow vehicles and car in the parking area. **PLEASE DO NOT PARK ON THE GRASS.**

Once unloaded please report to the Circuit Office for signing-on.

Please remember your club membership cards, competition licence and any outstanding payments.

The scrutineer will come round to your car. Main things are battery and seat security, brakes and steering.

There are two events taking place, the Autotest during the morning and a PCA in the late afternoon.

AUTOTEST TIMETABLE:

Signing on and scrutineering starts at **08:00 hours** and ends at **10:00 hours**.

Driver's briefing will be in the signing on office at **10:15 hours**.

First test to commence at **10:30 hours**.

There are four test sites. Diagrams are attached and on the club webpage <https://www.camconline.co.uk/events/2026-9-6/kennings-autotest-pca> and printed copies will be available at signing-on.

Competitors will be split into four groups, starting on different test sites. Each competitor will then attempt that test site twice before moving onto the next test area. Once all four test sites have been completed twice, i.e., after test number 8 there will be a lunch break. In the afternoon this will be repeated, making 16 tests in total. All count towards results.

Competitors will be permitted to walk the tests before 10:15 hours.

The last test will be at approximately **15:30 hours**.

PCA TIMETABLE:

Signing on and scrutineering starts at **08:00 hours** and ends at **10:00 hours**.

Driver's briefing will be in the signing on office at the conclusion of the Autotest.

First test to commence shortly after, at approximately **15:30 hours**. There are two test areas. The number of rounds and order will be decided by the Clerk of the Course on the day, although it is anticipated there will be six rounds, with a short break after the first three.

The last test will be at approximately **17:30 hours**.

CORRECTIONS & AMENDMENTS TO THE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

PCA 8. ENTRIES

PCA Entries will open on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and close at 10.00 hours on Sunday, 6th September 2026 subject to there being a minimum of 6 on-line entries being received by 19:00 hours on Thursday 3rd September 2026. If there are fewer than 6 entries by 03/09/2026 this section of the event may be cancelled.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

If you encounter any problems, such as mechanical gremlins, please inform the Clerk of the Course. We will try to accommodate any drivers encountering issues, provided they do not acquire an advantage with road position, for example, due to the weather,

Please check the Notice Board at the lunch interval to see how many tests will be run in the afternoon. In extreme weather conditions this may be reduced. It will not be increased. Your prompt starting of tests will allow us to be able to run all tests.

BONNETS. Please note that engine bays must have a cover (bonnet). Cars will not be permitted to start a test if the bonnet is not fitted correctly. This is for the safety of yourself and marshals.

START LINE. There will be two cones placed approximately a cars length before the start line where you may “prepare yourself to start”, such as going through the test diagram in your head, perhaps with a fellow competitor to confirm, or doing the “orchestra thing” with your hands. Once on the start line you will be classified as ready to start. Once the timekeeper instructs you that they are ready you should start within a few seconds. Only the competitor in his/her car and the Timekeeper/s are permitted in the Starting area.

MAXIMUMS. You are reminded that we are using the new “Competitors own fastest time on a test site plus 20 seconds” method for working out Wrong Test / Maximum times.

Toilets Are located in the building near the start line of Site C. These are not gender specific.
