Final Instructions

Thank you for your entry for this year's Stuff The Turkey PCA. Your competitor number will be allocated to you at signing-on.

Report to signing-on in the café (see diagram below). Signing-on opens at **8:00am** and closes at **9:00am**. Have your Competition Licence and Club Card ready for inspection. Sign-on if you have not already signed-on online. Printed copies of the test diagrams will be available, and your first timecard will be issued, along with a competition number for the windscreen.

Competitors may then "walk the tests".

There will be a driver's briefing at **9:45am**, near signing-on.

The first car will start at approximately **10:00am**.

There will be three rounds of four test sites in all, with a lunch break of approximately 30 minutes at some point during the day. The event should finish at around 3.30pm to 4pm.

Please be aware that the worst score for a competitor at each test site will be dropped from the overall results.



DUAL ENTRIES

For those sharing a vehicle: - Once the first driver has completed a test, the car should be handed over to the second driver and go to the start line of the same test by jumping any queue. We will try to alternate competition numbers of dual entries (e.g., car number 1 & 3), to keep the event flowing.

RUNNING OF TESTS

There will be four Test sites (A, B, C and D) and all competitors start in numerical order at Test Site A, subject to the condition described above for dual entries. On completing Test A, competitors will move on to Test B, and so on. After the first run on Test D, hand in your timecard at the café and collect the next timecard. The process is repeated until all competitors have attempted three runs at each test.

Additions and Amendments to the Supplementary Regulations

2. JURISDICTION

The meeting will be governed by the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport UK Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) these supplementary regulations and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.

7. CLASSES

Open top or Sports cars may compete with their hoods down or a hard top removed provided the passenger/navigator is 16 years old or over and at least 135cm in height.

13. RESULTS.

The worst score for a competitor at each test site will be dropped from the overall results.

14. AWARDS.

There will be awards allocated to both crew members for:

Fastest Time of the Day (1st overall).

1st, 2nd and 3rd in class A.

1st, 2nd and 3rd in class B.

Highest placed Lady Driver.
