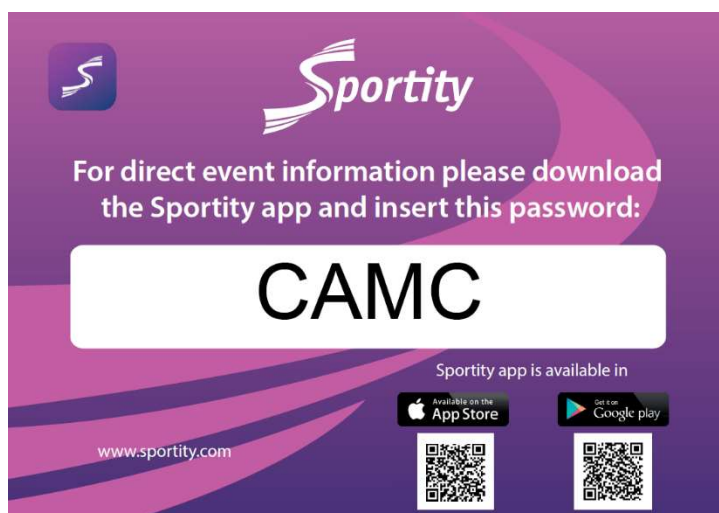

There will be a drivers' briefing at **09:15 hours** at the scrutineering garage and all competitors **MUST** attend. Timecards will be issued immediately after the driver's briefing.

Car 0 will start at MC1 at **10:00 hours** (for individual start times please add your car number to this time).

Car 0 is due at the finish at approximately **16:10 hours**.

Please arrive in good time:

In previous years' large numbers of competitors have left it until after 08:00 to arrive, which results in large queues for scrutineering & signing on, and ultimately last year led to a delay to starting the first test. In light of this we respectfully request that you work with us as organisers to keep the day on schedule.

- y. Leaving the track and placing all four wheels of the car on the grass infield/outfield

This will allow for us to allocate marshals to the most suitable locations before the morning of the event, and as such speed up the signing-on process.

ARRIVAL, SCRUTINEERING & SIGNING-ON

Arrival at the venue / Tickets

All crews will receive 6 tickets to the venue; 2 for the competing crew themselves and up to 4 for their respective marshal(s).

These tickets will be emailed to the **nominated email address on the entry form** and must be presented when arriving at the venue.

Driving Standards / Road Traffic Act

Please remember to drive safely and with respect for residents, Circuit staff, marshals and spectators.

Overnight Camping

Overnight camping is available at Trac Môn/Anglesey Circuit from 18:00 Saturday 18th, please do not pitch your caravan in the designated trailer parking or competitors' holding area. Electricity hook up is available and the café will be open for a period during Saturday evening.

Trailer Park

For competitors who wish to trailer their vehicles to the event, trailers and towing vehicles should be parked in the area allocated on the site map. Please note that this area is denoted as a prohibited area for competitors for the duration of the event once Car 1 has left MC0. Any competitor entering this area during the event without good reason will be deemed to be receiving outside assistance as defined in the SR's.

Fuel

Ensure that your vehicle has enough fuel at the start of the event, refuelling during the event is not permitted.

Marshals' Signing-on

Signing-on will be on the ground floor the Tower Building.

Competitors' Signing-on

Obtain a signature to indicate that your marshal has signed-on at the ground floor the Tower Building

Competitors' signing-on will be on the first floor the Tower Building.

Timecards will be issued following driver's briefing.

Track Sighting

Competitors are permitted to walk the circuit as detailed as follows:

- Track sighting by foot or pedal cycle is only permitted between 08:00 and 09:00
- All persons present on circuit during this period MUST wear hi-vis clothing.

Setup teams and their vehicles will be present on track during the sighting period. Please comply with any requirement of the event officials on track, and be vigilant of vehicles on track.

Test setup & signage may be incomplete at the time of track sighting due to ongoing setup. Competitors are reminded that their roadbook is their primary reference for all test layouts.
