Dear entrant,

Thank you for your entry to the first running of the Tour of Anglesey as a charity run. We are very grateful for your support to raise funds for a fantastic charity.

Certificate of Exemption No. 203014 has been issued by Motorsport UK.

If you require trailer parking, this is available at a secure location. Please contact Ilan (i.rhys18@gmail.com) to make reservations as space is limited, so please only use it if you need to.

START

Signing-on will be at Tacla Taid - the Anglesey Transport Museum, Newborough, LL61 6TN; what3words///**published.snoozing.hush** (O.S. Map Reference: 114/432 666) and will open from 08:15am on Saturday, 10th May and close at 09:15am.

Drivers' briefing will be held in the car park at 09:30 and at least one crew member from each car should attend. Please arrive early so we can get everyone signed on in due time so that we can depart at 10:00am prompt.

The cafe will be opened early for us on this day for hot beverages and bacon/sausage baps, so please come early to socialise over a cup of tea and support the venue.

Bragdu Lleu craft brewery will have a pop-up shop on site. However, they will not have a facility to take payment by card, so please bring cash for any proposed purchase of goods and raffle tickets.

LUNCH STOP

Lunch venue arrival should be approximately 12 noon. Please remember to bring your own lunch. There will be hot beverages available along with the famous Mônuts to buy at your own expense. However, service can be very slow here especially if it's busy so please be prepared for that.

FINISH

Finish will be at the Gadlys Bay View Bar & Restaurant, and we hope to arrive around 4pm.

We have been very lucky to acquire the venue free of charge, although it's still open to the public while we are there. Because of this they have asked that if anybody wants to dine in the restaurant while we are there, to pre order meals to help them out (Tel: 01407 710227).
