## **AWARDS**

Additional awards:

Under 21 Driver - Awarded to driver of the highest placed car who was aged 21 or under at time of entry and not winning an overall or class award.

Under 21 Navigator - Awarded to Navigator of the highest placed car who was aged 21 or under at time of entry and not winning an overall or class award.

1<sup>st</sup> Lady Driver - Awarded to driver of the highest placed car lady driver and not winning an overall or class award

1<sup>st</sup> Lady Navigator - Awarded to driver of the highest placed car lady navigator not winning an overall or class award.

Up to 1400 Capacity Cars: Awards to driver and navigator of the highest placed car of up to and including 1400 c.c. capacity not winning an overall or class award.

Competitors will only be awarded 1 of the above awards unless no other eligible crew complete the event.

Fastest time on the Special Test – Awarded to driver and navigator of the fastest car on the special test

Best Presented Car

All other awards remain as listed in the Supplementary Regulations, with 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> awarded in each class.

## **SPECIAL TEST**

If you experience a puncture on the special test PULL OVER immediately in a safe place. Failure to do so will be disqualification and incur the cost of any damage to track surface. Crews may replace a wheel and complete the test. Crews must wear a hi-viz if exiting the vehicle on the Special Test and failure to comply may result in disqualification.

All crews must carry Hi-Viz vests/tabards in case they need to exit their vehicles on the special test or walk the test prior to the start.

All Marshals MUST wear Hi-Viz clothing whilst carrying out their duties.

## **OTHER**

There is a bar at the start venue and any competing driver, navigator, or their marshal that is recorded consuming any drink containing alcohol will result in that crew not being allowed to start the event.

## **INSURANCE**

For drivers taking advantage of the REIS insurance scheme, the standard premium is £27 including tax.

For drivers who have a Letter of Acceptance, the premium is shown on the letter. If you do not comply with the eligibility criteria and do not have a Letter of Acceptance, you will not be allowed to start the event and will forfeit your entry fee.

Please read Bulletin 2 dated 7/2/24 to ensure that you comply with and understand the obligations and cover of the REIS insurance scheme. May we remind all crews that REIS Event insurance will not cover any damage to walls/fences/3<sup>rd</sup> party property. It is a legal requirement that any crew involved in causing damage to any 3<sup>rd</sup> party property, must stop competing and complete their damage declaration and present it to a member of the organizing team.

**All other drivers are required to supply the name and address of the vehicle's insurers and Insurance Agent – MotorSport UK General Regulations D.12.3.6 and R.5.1.2. Kindly bring your POLICY PROVIDER details and POLICY NUMBER with you to inform the C&A Motor Club official when collecting your rally pack.**

## **VEHICLES**

As this is one of the 1st Road Rallies of 2024, please ensure that your car complies with the 2024 Motorsport UK Blue Book regulations.

### **Driving Standards / Road Traffic Act**

Please remember to drive safely and show respect for residents, Circuit staff, marshals, and spectators.

### **Trailer Park**

For competitors who wish to trailer their vehicles to the event, trailers and towing vehicles should be parked in the area allocated on the site map.

### **Fuel**

Ensure that your vehicle has enough fuel at the start of the event.

Ensure you carry enough fuel to cover 40 miles.

There will be a petrol halt at halfway 95E10 and 99E5 – **This will be at Gwalia Bach Garage, Valley (on the crossroads). The shop will be open for cold drinks and sweets.**

Fuel is NOT available at Trac Môn.

## **Special Tests**

Signed-on competitors will be permitted to walk the tests up to 19:00 hours, prior to the drivers' briefing. ***Please wear a Hi-Viz – failure to do so may result in you not being able to start the event.***

## **Test Briefing**

A drivers' briefing for the special test will be held in the garage to the left of the Tower Building at 19:10hours. A check will be done to ensure all competitors have attended.

## **Drivers' Briefing**

A drivers' briefing will be held in the garage to the left of the Tower Building at 21:25hours. A check will be done to ensure all competitors have attended.

## **Test sighting run**

Due to the status of the event being for Novice and Beginner crews, and on safety grounds the organisers will arrange a sighting run for the special test for all competitors prior to the first competitor attempting the special test. This will be in the form of a convoy behind a safety car. All competitors are welcome to walk the test prior to the event, however the must all be off the track by 19:00


